

University of the Thai Chamber of Commerce Announcement Ref No. 3/2021

Guidelines for Teaching and Learning for Students, the Second Semester, Academic Year 2020

As the University of the Thai Chamber of Commerce has postponed the starting date of the second semester, academic year 2020 to 18th January 2021, reference is made to the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration on Order of the Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 16) dated the 4th January 2021 advising all educational institutions to extend the closure of physical campuses until 31st January 2021, therefore, the University of the Thai Chamber of Commerce would like students to follow the guidelines below:

- 1. All lecture-based classes are to be convened using the online system from 18 to 3th January 2021. Online classes must adhere to the timings prescribed by their assigned time tables. Online classes are required to be conducted via the following platforms:
 - 1) Cisco WebEx is mainly required for online interactive learning.
 - 2) Microsoft Teams is mainly required for class attendance/lessons, activities and assignment submission.
- 2. Courses that require physical operations or are unable to be conducted online will be postponed until after January 31, 2022. Class makeups will be scheduled by each school.
- 3. Prior to the beginning of semester and during late registration and add/drop periods, students can access the online class information from the academic service system at https://reg.utcc.ac.th/ (for small-size classes students can access the online class information from Microsoft Teams by logging in at https://login.microsoft.com/ with UTCC Email).
- 4. In case of inability to access an online class with UTCC Email, please contact the Office of Computer Services via LINE of Facebook Page as shown in the attached sheet.
- 5. To file a petition during late registration and add/drop periods, students can download and send a document in pdf or jpg form to the school email or other communication channels.

6. To submit a petition of expectation for completing degree, request a transcript and certifying letter, students can contact the Office of the Registrar and submit an online petition form at https://reginfo.utcc.ac.th/onlinerequest

Students can read online handbooks for accessing academic service system and for attending class on Cisco WebEx and Microsoft Teams at https://reg.utcc.ac.th/, UTCC Plus Application and other channels such as Registrar UTCC และ UTCC News via Facebook Page.

7. Any further changes will be announced by the university.
